## THE HISTORY OF *Afternoon Tea*

Anna, The 7th Duchess of Bedford is often credited with the invention of the tradition of Afternoon Tea in the early 1840s. During this period, dinner was not served until 8.30 or 9.30 in the evening, so she often became hungry, so she ordered a small meal of bread, butter and other niceties, to be brought secretly to her boudoir. When she was exposed, she was not ridiculed as she feared, but her habit caught on and the concept of a small meal of niceties such as cakes, tarts, biscuits and tea, became popular and eventually became known as, 'Afternoon Tea'. Now it is a ceremony of celebration for many people and a real social event.
